## **Trips 2017 – South Coast**

Dear Travel Club Member,

Please find below the Travel Club trips for May 2017: -

**10:00am on Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2017**

**Please do not call before the above time & date or leave phone messages on the above date as bookings will not be taken. Please also note that pick-up times are approximate**

**Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> May – Cooden Beach Hotel** - sited on the seafront, this modern mock Tudor-style hotel with 2 acres of gardens in a lovely setting. Enjoy a 2 course lunch for £15 or a 3 course lunch for £20 in the Brasserie on the Beach restaurant. Lunch booked for 1pm.

**Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> May - Paradise Park Timely Talks - “The Colourful Life”** – an interesting perennial palette of plants and attractive combinations. Special plant offer. The talk starts at 11am in the Coffee Shop and lasts approximately 50 minutes. Free entry. Free tea or coffee in the interval. After the talk you will have time for a browse around the garden centre and enjoy a light lunch.

**Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> May – Horns Lodge, South Chailey** – the Horns Lodge is a traditional, historic, rural pub dating back 200 years. It was one of a string of coaching houses on the London to Brighton postal route, with each coach sounding a horn on arrival – hence the name! Starters from £5.75 & Mains from £9.95. Lunch booked for 1pm.

**Saturday, 6<sup>th</sup> May – Standen House** – set in an idyllic location with views across the Sussex countryside this house designed by Philip Webb is one of the finest examples of Arts and Crafts workmanship with Morris & Co interiors creating a warm and welcoming atmosphere. The house is dressed for a weekend stay in 1925 so you can imagine you are a guest of the family. There is also a café and gift shop. This is a National Trust property so make sure you bring your card with you if you are a member, if not entry will be £11.50 payable on the day. Up to 3 hours to browse. **Access – wheelchairs can access ground floor of house, café and part of the gardens.**

**Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> May – Splash Point Jazz, Seaford Head Golf Club** – located at the end of Southdown Road above the Seaford Head Golf Course, The View Restaurant serves excellent food. By special request from some of our members who visited this restaurant in February we have booked lunch and the Jazz performance which on this day will be Mark Cherrie a professional steel pan player. Tickets are £24.95 to include a 3 course lunch and the Jazz performance. The performance commences at 4pm and ends at 6.15pm. Lunch booked for 2pm.

**Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> May – Haskins Roundstone Garden Centre** - visit this award winning garden centre in Angmering West Sussex. For all of you who enjoy your crafts you will be able to visit HOBBYCRAFT, the UK's largest chain of dedicated Arts & Crafts Superstores which is just next door. As requested no alternative venue has been arranged for lunch, so you will be able to spend all your time at Haskins and enjoy lunch in their light and airy café. Up to 3 hours to browse.

**Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> May - Hillcrest Lunch** – always a good trip as you will have the opportunity to enjoy a home cooked lunch and the chance to meet some of the CTLA team, prices are £6 for a main course and puddings are £2.80. Lunch booked for 12.30pm.

**Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> May – Barnsgate Manor, near Uckfield** - enjoy a trip to Barnsgate Manor and a spot of lunch. Please note that no pre order has been arranged, which allows you to make your choice on the day, however, this may result in the service being a little slower than usual, giving you a perfect opportunity to sit back, relax and enjoy being out with your Travel Club friends. 2 Courses for £15 or 3 Courses for £18. Lunch booked for 12.30pm.

**Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> May – Langney Market & Sovereign Harbour** - based at Langney shopping centre this Saturday Market open from 9am is very popular. You will have the opportunity to purchase local produce such as meat, vegetables, cakes and jams as well as locally made crafts. After a browse we will then take you to Sovereign Harbour where you can get a bite to eat from the wide selection of cafes and restaurants or maybe look around some of the larger stores. **Pickups start at 8:30am.**

**Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> May – Plough & Harrow, Litlington** – this 17<sup>th</sup> Century pub is located in the South Downs National Park. It has great food and a friendly atmosphere. Roasts from £8.95 & Desserts from £3.95. Lunch booked for 1pm. **ACCESS – as this is a 17<sup>th</sup> Century pub there are a couple of small steps inside.**

**Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> May - Holmbush & Longshore** - a few hours shopping in Next, Tesco's and Marks & Spencer, then lunch is booked for 1.30pm at the Longshore. If you would prefer to stay at Holmbush then please can you let us know at the time of booking. Remember that the Longshore offers 2 meals for the price of 1.

**Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> May – Worthing Market** – Worthing Market open from 9am to 5pm is a hugely popular outdoor market that has over 75 pitches set out through the main pedestrian shopping area. The site is surrounded by good cafes for when you need to rest your feet. Up to 3 hours to browse. Pick-ups will start from 9am.

**Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> May – Camelia Botnar Garden Centre & Bistro** – a large nursery selling quality plants, bedding & trees at competitive prices. Gift shop and showrooms of ironwork, woodwork and pottery. Why not treat yourself to a light lunch in the bistro serving fresh homemade food. Up to 3 hours to browse.

**Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> May – Wishing Well Tea Rooms** - the Wishing Well is a very popular tea room set in the Sussex countryside, nestling under the magnificent South Down's in Wilmington Village, Polegate. This Tea Room enjoys wonderful reviews. Snack lunches available from £4.50 to £7 or Cream Teas from £9.25 to £12.50. If you are gluten free please inform at time of booking. Lunch booked for 1pm.

**Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> May – Hydro Hotel** – the Crystal Room has been booked which is always a popular venue for Sunday lunch. A 3 course meal is £21. Lunch booked for 1pm.

**Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May – Bluebell Railway** – this was advertised in the March Newsletter and the trip is now full.

**Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> May - Shopping Shuttle** – we will drop you either at Sainsbury or Lidl's in Newhaven or Morrisons in Seaford. You will have around 2 hours to shop before we come and collect you. Please let the office know at the time of booking which store you wish to visit. Peacehaven and Newhaven members may be dropped off and collected at different times to the Seaford members.

**Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> May – Afternoon Tea + Film (Mary Poppins) Hydro Hotel** – this was advertised in the April Newsletter but there are still places available. **If you wish to go on this trip then you can ring before 25<sup>th</sup> April to book it up.** £17.50 non refundable payment required asap.

**Sunday, 28<sup>th</sup> May – Kings Head, Rye** – the Kings Head Inn a cream painted 17<sup>th</sup> century coaching inn situated on the outskirts of the picturesque town of Rye, one of the most visited places in the whole of the south of England. Starters from £4.50, Mains from £9.95 & Desserts from £5.95. Lunch booked for 1pm.

**Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> May – Hilliers Garden Centre, Stone Cross** - enjoy a ride out to this very popular garden centre where you can wander around looking at the great variety of goods on sale, from clothes, shoes, ornaments to plants. After looking around you will be able to get a coffee or a bite to eat at the highly popular restaurant Café Pine where they serve tasty daily specials. Up to 3 hours to browse. Pick ups will start at 9am.

**Wednesday, 31<sup>st</sup> May – Sheffield Park** - walk around the landscaped gardens and enjoy the beautiful and lush scenery, you can take your own lunch or enjoy a bite to eat at the Coach House Tea Rooms. As well as the recently refurbished shop in the reception building, they also now have a second shop located in the Coach House, next to the secondhand bookshop. Each of these shops contain a unique selection of products from the exclusive National Trust ranges and local suppliers. Entrance is £11.20 per person – free to National Trust Members so if you are a member please remember to bring your card with you. **Access – the majority of garden is accessible, there are some slopes and paths made of a non-gravel surface, accessible toilets adjacent to reception and in Tea Room, Tea Room has easy sloped access for wheelchairs, mobility scooters are available to borrow - please call 01825 790231 to book one for your visit (please book under your own name) please note a minimum donation of £2 is requested.** Up to 3 hours to browse.
