Thursday 2nd May - Bluebell Railway Observation Train - Fare £15 - Enjoy a special 'once a year opportunity' to ride on the observation train to view the bluebell fields in comfort. An hour and a half of spectacular views and time to enjoy a light refreshment. Train fare £17.00 pre-payable by Friday 26th April 2019.

Saturday 4th May - Chichester free day - Fare £17 - Chichester is a cathedral city in West Sussex. It has a long history as a settlement from Roman times and was important in Anglo-Saxon times. The Market Cross is the centre of town and South Street is one of the 4 main shopping streets radiating out from it. Have a wander around the town and treat yourself to a lunch in one of the many restaurants and cafes. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Saturday 4th May - Tottington Manor West Sussex - Fare £14 - Enjoy stunning views of the South Downs in this beautiful restaurant. Dishes are freshly prepared using locally sourced ingredients where possible and a vast choice is available. Choose between one course £13.50, two course £16.50 or three course £19.50. Lunch booked for 12.00 noon and has full disabled access.

Sunday 5th May - South Downs Garden Centre- Hassocks - Fare £14 - South Downs Garden Centre in Hassocks is the 48th largest garden centre in the UK. It is family owned and has undergone considerable expansion over the years to turn it into a modern and large garden centre. The outdoor plant area is large and very pleasantly designed with lots of interesting features to break up the area into compartments. All paths are solid surface and the plants are attractively displayed. The cafe serves snacks, cakes, main meals and a choice of hot and cold drinks including wines and beers. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Thursday 9th May - Kings College Lunch - Fare £13 - The popular Kings Restaurant offers lunch with the finest quality food and wine in intimate surroundings at the Eastbourne campus. Award winning students prepare, cook and serve guests in the restaurant under professional supervision as part of their training. Lunch is booked for 12 noon, 3 courses £13.50.

Friday 10th May - Holmbush - Fare £15 - Up to 3.5 hours to browse in Next, Tesco's and Marks & Spencer. Such a lovely large store with spacious coffee shop serving everything from sandwiches and cake to hot meals including fish and chips.

Saturday 11th May - Hillier Garden Centre Horsham - Fare £15 - This extensive garden centre has a wide variety of plants as well as an exciting range of garden products and gifts. On site there is an Edinburgh Woollen Mill, Cotton Traders and Pavers shop and then enjoy a visit to Café Rowan which is fully licensed and serves delicious hot and cold food. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Saturday 11th May - The Thatched Inn - Hassocks - Fare £13 - Nestling at the foot of the South Downs, the Thatched Inn with its picturesque roof of Norfolk reeds and oak beams, has spectacular views over the Sussex countryside to the Ditching Beacon. Pre-order at time of booking, lunch is booked for 12.00 noon.

Sunday 12th May - Hydro Hotel Lunch Eastbourne - Fare £13 - The Crystal Room has been booked which is always a popular venue for lunch. A three course lunch for £20., includes tea or coffee. Lunch is booked for 12.30pm.

Monday 13th May - Bignor Roman Villa Pulborough - Fare £17 - Bignor Roman Villa is situated in the centre of the designated South Downs National Park, only metres from the Downs themselves. The site commands unrivalled views of the Downs to South, East and West with instant access to miles of beautiful footpaths heading in all directions. Bignor village is only metres away with beautiful houses and gardens as well as a 13th Century church. There is a café where you can enjoy hot or cold drinks, locally made cakes and cream teas (please note they do not serve sandwiches or hot food) and shop on site. Entrance fee is £4.50. Please note this will be an early start as we would like to arrive at Bignor between 11 & 11.30am. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Thursday 16th May - Duddles Well Tearoom - Fare £13 - Set in the heart of the Ashdown Forest, enjoy a light lunch or a freshly baked Duddleswell afternoon tea. Lunch is booked for 12.30pm.

Saturday 18th May - Shopping in Burgess Hill - Fare £14 - Choose between visiting the Market Place, Martletts Shopping Centre or for those who are able, why not visit both. Burgess Hill offers a good selection of shops and the market place offers everything you need in just one place. When you need a rest you will have plenty of cafes or restaurants to choose from. This is a free day, perfect for those of you who want to meet up with friends or who want to please yourself. Up to 3.5 hours to browse.

Sunday 19th May - The White Hart Lewes - Fare £12 - On Sundays The White Hart Hotel offers a varied selection of choice. Lunch is booked for 12.30pm, in the newly refurbished conservatory. Carvery and dessert £13.00.

Monday 20th May - Hangleton Manor - Hove - Fare £13 - Hangleton Manor offers a truly unique and historical setting, with hearty home cooked food and award-winning ales, come and let the history sink in and the hustle and bustle of modern day life melt away. If the sun's out, you can take advantage of the stunning garden... but watch out for the ghost pigeons! Lunch is booked for 12.30pm and pre-order required at time of booking.

Thursday 23rd May - The Beacon (Arndale) - Fare £13 - Enjoy a few hours to shop at the Arndale Centre.

Friday 24th May - Weald and Downland Living Museum - Fare £18 - Come and discover rescued rural homes and buildings set in a beautiful landscape in the South Downs National Park. The collection tells the stories of people who lived and worked in rural South East England over 1,000 years. They hold a regular programme of demonstrations, including milling in the 17th century working watermill, cooking in the Tudor kitchen and seasonal demonstrations. There are beautiful landscapes, livestock and a waterfront café available for refreshments. Entry £10.60 pre-payable by Friday 3rd May 2019. Up to 3.5 hours to browse.

Saturday 25th May - Mystery Tour - Fare £14 - Enjoy a ride out on our mystery tour, a mystery destination only our drivers know where you will be driven.

Saturday 25th May - Brighton City Airport Lunch - Fare £14 - This Airport is an exciting place to visit any time of the year. With stunning Sussex views it is the perfect place to spend a few hours in art deco splendour, enjoying a light lunch in the Hummingbird restaurant. Lunch is booked for 12.00 noon.

Sunday 26th May - The Moorings - Pevensey - Fare £14 - Enjoy a scenic drive out to Pevensey Bay and lunch at the wonderful Moorings Restaurant. The Moorings is a traditional English restaurant serving good quality food at reasonable prices, choose from their extensive menu. This weekend prices are £5 starter and £10 main. Lunch is booked for 12.00 noon.

Tuesday 28th May - Leonardslee Lakes and Gardens Lower Beeding - Fare £15 - The 'Finest Spring Gardens in England', the 240 acre Leonardslee estate at Lower Beeding, near Horsham in West Sussex where visitors can explore a wide range of features including the elegant 19th-century Italianate-style Mansion House, listed Grade II for architectural merit, the unique dolls' house exhibition - and the rare colony of wallabies, wildfowl and huge carp in the seven ponds. Wide selections of refreshments are available from the new restaurants and tea rooms. Up to 3.5 hours to browse, entry £11 on the day.

Thursday 30th May - The Yew Tree Chalvington - Fare £12 - The Yew Tree Inn, Chalvington serve traditional pub food, like delicious homemade lasagne and warming liver and bacon. Starters from £4.95 and mains from £9.50. Lunch is booked for 12.30pm.

Few Spaces Remaining - Chichester Ship Canal - Private CTLA Charter with Fish and Chip Lunch

Enjoy a continuously changing scene in the heart of the countryside. A private charter for CTLA along the quiet Canal, rural waterway offering a cruise time of approximately 2 hours.
