

Trips 2017 – South Coast

Dear Travel Club Member,

Please find below the Travel Club trips for June 2017: -

10:00am on Tuesday, 23rd May, 2017

Please do not call before the above time & date or leave phone messages on the above date as bookings will not be taken. Please also note that pick-up times are approximate

Thursday, 1st June – Rye Market – we will take you to the beautiful town of Rye where you can visit the market or take a stroll around the town. We have left you free to get lunch when and where you wish in Rye as there are many lovely places to get a meal. Up to 3 hours to browse. Pick ups will start at 8am.

Saturday, 3rd June – Day by the Sea, Hippodrome, Eastbourne – this trip was advertised in the April Newsletter and is now fully booked.

Sunday, 4th June –The Cock Inn, Ringmer - Sunday lunch has been booked at this charming 16th century coaching Inn. The Cock has a wonderful unspoilt bar with original oak beams, a flag stone floor and an Inglewood fireplace. Starters from £5.95, Mains from £9.95 or Roast (choice of 3 meats) from £12.50 & Desserts £6. Lunch booked for 12 noon. **Access - Please note that there are 6 steps leading up to the pub, as this is an old building there is no disabled toilet, but the toilets are large enough for walkers.**

Tuesday, 6th June – Litlington Tea Gardens – the Tea shop and gardens are set in one of the quietest and most unspoiled corners of Sussex where you can enjoy a Traditional cream tea with homemade cakes (light lunches are also available) surrounded by a delightful display of flowers, plants shrubs and old trees. After lunch you will have time for a wander around the Nursery, Crystal Shop and Craft shop. Please note that no Debit or Credit cards are accepted, cash only. We have reserved undercover seats just in case the weather is inclement. Lunch booked for 12 noon. Up to 3 hours to browse. **Access - there is a path leading up to the Tea Rooms so it is suitable for wheelchairs and walkers, however, please note there are no disabled toilets.**

Wednesday, 7th June - Paradise Park Timely Talks - “The Rosarians Dream” – a look at roses for the perfect rose garden and plans to complement the theme. Special plant offer. The talk starts at 11am in the Coffee Shop and lasts approximately 50 minutes. Free entry. Free tea or coffee in the interval. After the talk you will have time for a browse around the garden centre and enjoy a light lunch.

Friday, 9th June – Russells Garden Centre, Birdham – Russells is a family run garden centre in the pretty harbour village of Birdham near Chichester, West Sussex. It proved very popular on our last visit there so we thought we would offer it again. Take time to explore the unique lifestyle store, interior oak furniture showrooms, gift shop, plant centre, sweets and treats shop and award winning restaurant. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Saturday, 10th June – Mystery Tour - CTLA's most popular trip is back for the summer of 2017. It truly is a mystery destination, only our drivers know (with a little help from the office) where you will be driven. Enjoyed by so many of our members, make sure you book early in order not to miss out.

Sunday, 11th June – Cheneys Lodge Seaford – Cheneys restaurant boasts fresh modern décor and a relaxed yet welcoming atmosphere. Fully accessible for wheelchairs, all level access with no steps. Their chef has previously worked in a number of premium London hotel restaurants. They have a full alcohol licence so why not choose a nice bottle of something to accompany your lunch. Choice of roast beef or turkey with all the trimmings followed by a choice of desserts all for £11.00. Lunch booked for 1pm.

Tuesday, 13th June - Hillcrest Lunch – always a good trip as you will have the opportunity to enjoy a home cooked lunch and the chance to meet some of the CTLA team, prices are £6 for a main course and puddings are £2.80. Lunch booked for 12.30pm.

Wednesday, 14th June – Carpet of Flowers – Arundel – for over 100 years Arundel Cathedral has celebrated the feast of Corpus Christi with a festival of flowers which includes a magnificent carpet of flowers in the central aisle of the Cathedral. There is no charge for admission and refreshments are available throughout the day in the Cathedral Centre, a short distance from the Cathedral. There will also be numerous floral displays around the Cathedral. Flower arrangers are invited to take part and are given a free hand in the design of displays. The display is open from 9.30am to 8pm. We will aim to get you there by 11am and allow up to 3 hours to browse.

Friday, 16th June - Old Plough, Seaford - this is a great town centre pub offering fantastic value delicious pub food and local ales from Sussex. Starters from £3.99, Mains from £8.29 & Desserts from £3.99. Lunch booked for 1pm.

Saturday, 17th June – Michelham Priory – WWII Weekend – this popular WW2 event gives you a chance to come and take a step back into the 1940's and learn more about life during WW2. They will have 1940's entertainment, vehicles and displays, WW2 themed food, artefacts, music and more a real tribute to the 40's. Wartime artefacts, food and vehicles. Entrance fee £9.40 (concessions £8.40) payable on the day. The day runs from 10.30am to 5pm. We will aim to get you there by 11am and allow up to 3 hours to browse. **Access – the gardens, ground floor of the house, cafe, barn, shop and mill are all accessible.**

Sunday, 18th June – Halfway House, Isfield – this is a traditional public house in the heart of the Sussex countryside with locally sourced home cooked food. Starters from £5.95, Sunday Roast £11.95 & Desserts from £4.95. Lunch booked for 1pm. **Access – disabled access at the back of the pub and there is a disabled toilet.**

Monday 19th June - Heaven Farm - enjoy a scenic drive and lunch at Heaven Farm, Uckfield Set in 100 acres of beautiful parkland, Heaven Farm is steeped in 600 years of farming history and includes the bluebell nature trail which has featured many times on BBC TV. Lunch is booked in their Stable Tea Rooms where you can enjoy a light lunch or treat yourself to a traditional Sussex cream tea. After lunch you will have the chance to have a look around the farm if you would like, or just browse around their organic and craft shop. Lunch booked for 1pm.

Tuesday, 20th June - Holmbush & Longshore - a few hours shopping in Next, Tesco's and Marks & Spencer, then lunch is booked for 1.30pm at the Longshore. If you would prefer to stay at Holmbush then please can you let us know at the time of booking. Remember that the Longshore offers 2 meals for the price of 1.

Thursday, 22nd June – Chichester Canal – Fish & Chip Cruise – this trip advertised in the April 2017 Newsletter and is now fully booked.

Saturday, 24th June – CTLA Afternoon Tea with Songs of Yesteryear – Meridian Centre, Peacehaven – 3pm to 5.30pm
- there are still some tickets left for this event which was advertised in the May Newsletter. Tickets £8 – free transport for CTLA Members (subject to availability).

Sunday, 25th June – Raystede Annual Summer Fayre - 10am to 4pm – this wonderful event offers something for everyone – watch the displays and also visit the animals – refreshments available from the bar and café. Entrance fee only £4 payable on the day. All proceeds from the day go to caring for the animals.

Monday, 26th June – Hole Park, Cranbrook – this is one of the best known gardens in Kent, a wonderful 16 acre garden in a magical parkland setting. Why not visit the newly refurbished Coach House tea room where you can get homemade teas and light lunches. Entrance fee £7 payable on the day. Up to 3 hours to browse. Pick ups will start at 8.30am. **Access - the garden is accessible to all as they have removed many steps and provided a hard surface loop around most of the garden.**

Wednesday, 28th June – Squires Garden Centre, Washington - the garden centre has been a thriving part of the community for over 20 years and now includes a huge plant area and great gardening products, gifts, pets, aquatics and garden furniture as well as a farm shop, pottery painting studio and Squire's Café Bar. It also boasts the largest range of water features in the area. Up to 3 hours to browse.

Thursday, 29th June - Shopping Shuttle – we will drop you either at Sainsbury or Lidl's in Newhaven or Morrisons in Seaford. You will have around 2 hours to shop before we come and collect you. Please let the office know at the time of booking which store you wish to visit. Peacehaven and Newhaven members may be dropped off and collected at different times to the Seaford members.


