Saturday 1st February - Scotney Castle Lamberhurst - Fare £18 - Relax in the picturesque garden with the glorious backdrop of the fairytale castle. Enjoy a delicious meal in the tea-room or bring your own food along to eat in the newly created woodland picnic area. This is a National Trust property so make sure you bring your card with you if you are a member, if not entry will be £14.20 payable on the day. There is over 770 acres to explore, **partly accessible grounds with map's available to show route. There are steps to the entrance of building and terraces, ramp for access to ground floor and a gravel approach. Accessible toilets available in the outside gardens.** Up to 3 hours to browse.

Sunday 2nd February - The Yew Tree Chalvington - Fare £13 - The Yew Tree Inn, Chalvington serve traditional pub food, like delicious homemade lasagne and warming liver and bacon. Starters from £4.95 and mains from £9.50. Lunch is booked for 12.00 noon.
